Our **Fond du Lac Says No More** initiative is the largest public awareness and advocacy campaign ever undertaken in the history of the Fond du Lac Area Women's Fund.

The initiative focuses on the prevention of power-based violence with specific attention to reducing sexual assault, domestic violence and child abuse throughout Fond du Lac County. Phase I got under way in 2018 and continued throughout 2019 with a goal of raising awareness and providing tools for the community to help in the reduction of power-based incidents. **Project Table Talk** and **Green Dot Bystander Intervention** projects were unveiled in Phase I. Phase II will add in opportunities to engage more men and boys in speaking out against violence against women and children. This is an opportunity to expand the positive energy of the Women's Fund's FDL Says No More initiative to showcase ideas and involvement of good men stepping forward to ensure their voices rise above the deeds of abusive men.
